Year 7 Subjects

- ▶ The core units include English, Mathematics, Science, HSIE and PDHPE.
- ► The other subjects students study in Year 7 are Technology and Applied Studies (TAS), Visual Arts, Music, Sport and LOTE (Chinese).
- Students will also participate in Project Based Learning and Social/Emotional Learning activities

The Timetable

- The school operates on a two week timetable. Week A and Week B. Each term begins on a Week A
- There are 5 sessions in a day. The day is structured with 2 sessions before recess,
 2 sessions between recess and lunch and 1 session after lunch.
- Roll Call occurs before school each morning.
- On Monday and Wednesday mornings students have assembly / roll call on the quadrangle.
- Students are provided with individual timetables. Students should make multiple copies of their timetables, with one copy kept in their school diary and another copy kept separately at home.

Uniform and Uniform Purchases

- ► The handbook contains details of the school uniform and the types of footwear which is acceptable under the school's Uniform Policy and meets Work, Health and Safety requirements. Parents, please read this section of the handbook BEFORE purchasing items of uniform.
- ► The school uniform is available to purchase from Lowes at Seven Hills except for the sports shirt and school jacket which can be purchased from our school. Due to Covid-19 restrictions the sports shirts and the school jackets will be available to purchase on-line only.
- ► The office will keep a list of Year 7 students that have paid on-line and the students can collect the sports shirts and jackets from the office at the start of 2021.

Parents, if you require support in purchasing uniform, please contact the school and discuss your situation with the Principal, Mr Johnstone.
