
FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Remembering Uncle Wes Marne AM

Sunrise 25 April 1922 ~ Sunset 31 August 2024



Uncle Wes was a unique individual who left an indelible mark on all he met. A distinguished Bigambul Elder and storyteller, Uncle Wes profoundly influenced Blacktown City and its surrounding communities through his deep commitment to First Nations culture. Our school was fortunate to have Uncle Wes grace us with his presence on two occasions in 2024. In February, he led a professional learning morning for all staff, sharing his personal stories. In July, he attended our school's NAIDOC Week assembly and led the Acknowledgement of Country and a smoking ceremony.

Born in 1922, he spent over half a century in Mount Druitt before passing away on August 31, 2024, at the age of 102. Highly regarded as an Elder, advocate, and educator, Uncle Wes was celebrated for his storytelling and efforts to share traditional knowledge across schools, universities, and yarning circles in Australia.

He was personally responsible for bringing the Smoking Ceremony tradition to Sydney.

A key figure in the Mount Druitt and District Reconciliation Group, Uncle Wes was honoured with the Key to Blacktown City in 2022 and appointed a Member of the Order of Australia for his dedicated service. His achievements also included being named an Honorary Fellow at Western Sydney University and receiving the NSW Department of Education's Nanga Mai Love of Learning Award. He played a crucial role in advocating for a pre-school for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and made notable contributions through his book of poems and the acclaimed show "Fire Bucket." Uncle Wes's legacy of service and dedication will be deeply missed and remembered by locals from all walks of life.

Uncle Wes' grandfather, another storyteller, taught him that every star in the sky is a First Nations person sitting around their fire, waiting their turn to be reincarnated.

Vale Uncle Wes. We will be looking for your star in the night sky.
